

(1) Emergency Call-Out Team

- (1.1) The Emergency Call-Out Team will be selected each season by the Club Captain. The group will consist of experienced IRB Drivers and emergency care personnel
- (1.2) The Call-Out Team for 2010/11 consists of Shannon Job, Paul Mathew, Paul Friedmann, Jon Colwell, Richard Donaldson, Joe Mastrangelo, and Bernie Burrows

(2) Procedure

- (2.1) The SNB Emergency Services Officer shall contact members of the call-out team via mobile phone, by the order of names listed in (1.2)
- (2.2) The first person to speak to the SNB Officer should take brief details of the incident, and then ring around to the remainder of the team. A minimum of two members must be available before team members confirm with SNB that North Steyne can respond to the Call-Out
- (2.3) Team members should bring the following to any call-out, as a minimum:
 - (2.3.1) Wetsuit
 - (2.3.2) IRB Rash Shirt
 - (2.3.3) Patrol Cap
 - (2.3.4) Water Bottle
- (2.4) IRB should be prepped as soon as team members arrive. This especially includes warming up the IRB motor, setting up two (2) IRB radios, and filling two (2) fuel bladders
- (2.5) If poor weather conditions or night-time, Call-Out team members should use the Patrol Spray-Jackets in the patrol room

(3) Authority to Launch

- (3.1) In a Call-Out, **no member of the team will launch an IRB** without the presence of either the Club Captain, the IRB Captain, or the SNB Duty Officer
