COVID-19 INFORMATION

Please DONOT attend the carnival if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or have suffered from COVID-19 in the past 14 days or have visited a COVID hotspot in the past 14 days. Refer to following website for latest hotspot information –

Any person involved in this event that over the age of 16 must carry evidence of being fully vaccinated against Covid-19.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

There is no Competitor Registration required on the day of the event.



All competitors must have their **Age Group & Competitor Entry ID** clearly marked on their left wrist or left arm prior to marshalling. e.g. U9 42. The **Competitor Entry ID** will be published on the Carnival Programs web page prior to the event – <https://www.surflifesaving.net.au/surf-sports/carnivals/programs/>

Program will be a **Fast Fives** format – Board – Swim – Board – Swim – Board, with A & B Finals.

Competitors must compete in their own age group only, in both individual and team events.

We ask all competitors not to arrive to the beach earlier than 30 minutes before their start time where possible, to minimize the number of people at the beach.

5 Mins Warm-up will be permitted only after competitors have been called into the Marshaling Area from the Staging Area.

Note¹: Mixed Board Relay will be run only if time permits – no A & B finals. Mixed Board Relay team composition is minimum of 1 Male and 1 Female. If there are more than one team per club event, please distinguish the teams as **RED, BLUE, GREEN** team etc, and ensure that this is written on their arms before the relays.

TEAM/AGE MANAGERS

Team Managers/Age Managers will be required to nominate to be able to enter the staging and competition area. Upon arrival they will need to scan the event QR code and provide evidence of their Covid-19 vaccination at the entry to the Field of Play, and they will then receive a wrist band which will provide them access.

PARENTS & SPECTATORS

We encourage parents to drop off their children and leave the area. We will allow for a small number of spectators at the carnival in designated spectator areas only on the walkway above the beach, with the following provisions –

- All spectators must maintain social distancing of a minimum of 1.5m from anyone who is not from the same household
- All spectators must check in to the event using the carnival QR code that is available on the Carnival Program webpage and will also be available at the event.
- Any spectators that are over 16 years of age **MUST** be fully vaccinated against Covid-19, and ensure they are carrying evidence of their vaccination status

COVID Marshals will be in attendance to monitor attendance numbers and ensure appropriate social distancing is being adhered to. Only designated team managers / age managers will be permitted into the field of play. Spectators are not allowed to enter the field of play.

CLUB TENTS

Club tents will be permitted to be set up on the beach within the competition area (field of play) and will be dedicated for use by competitors only. Tents need to be erected prior to competition starting. Club tents will be shared amongst competitors from all clubs, so please ensure that you do not pack up your tent before competition ends.

No competitor tents are permitted on the walkway or grassed area above the beach.
